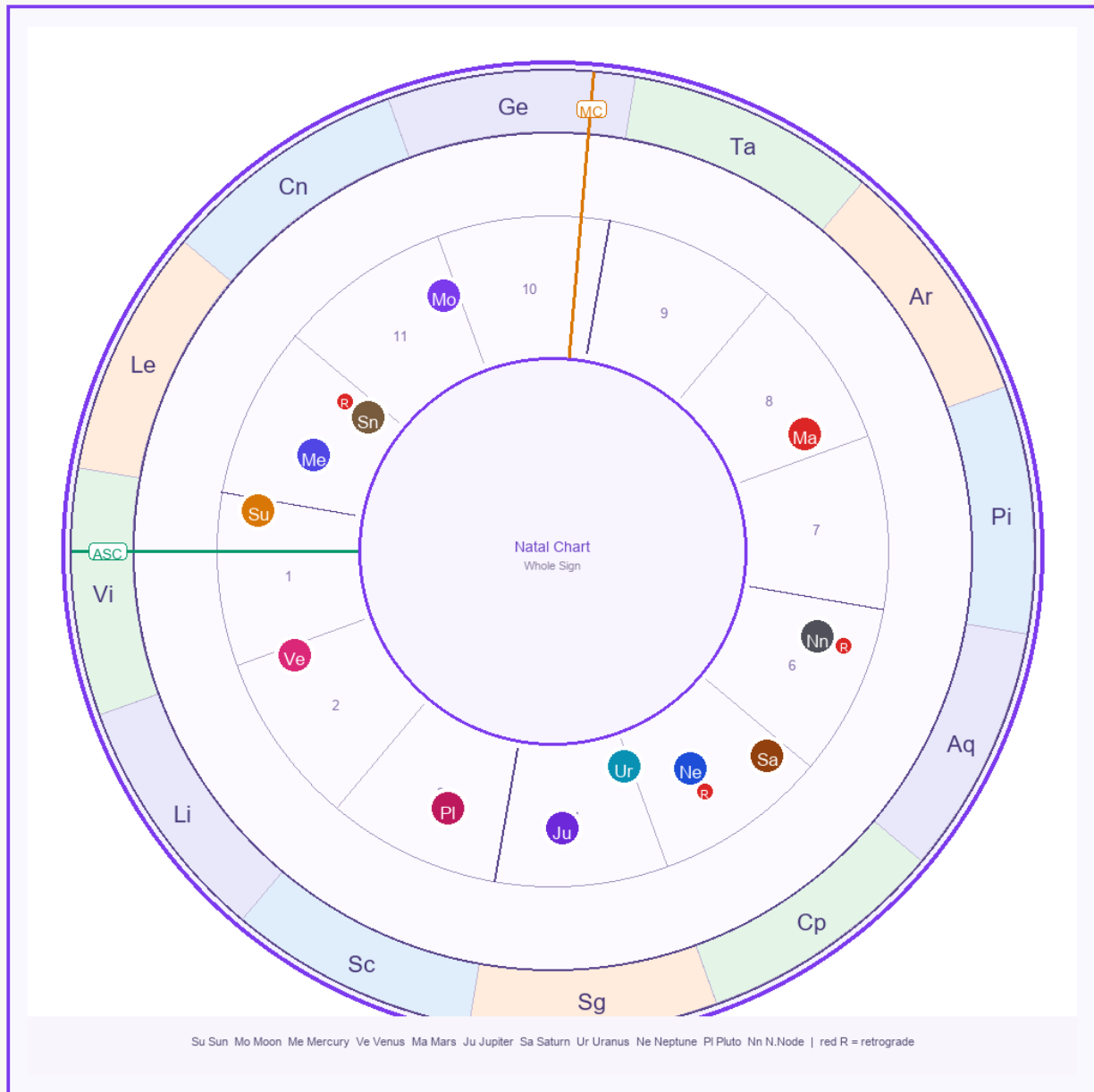

HOUSES - LIFE STAGES

Where planetary energy plays out (Whole Sign from the Ascendant)

Houses are the rooms of a life. Planets are the people in those rooms. Empty rooms still matter - their themes run through the house cusp and its ruler.

1ST HOUSE - SELF, BODY & FIRST IMPRESSIONS

The 1st house is the doorway of the chart - how you enter a room, how life first meets you, and the body you live inside. Planets here color your vitality, style of initiative, and the persona people encounter before they know your deeper layers.

Natal occupants: Ascendant (Rising) in Virgo.

Planets in the 1st house amplify self-expression. They rarely stay private - they walk through the front door with you. Read each occupant as a trait people meet early, and as a lifelong project of embodying that planet well.

2ND HOUSE - MONEY, VALUES & SELF-WORTH

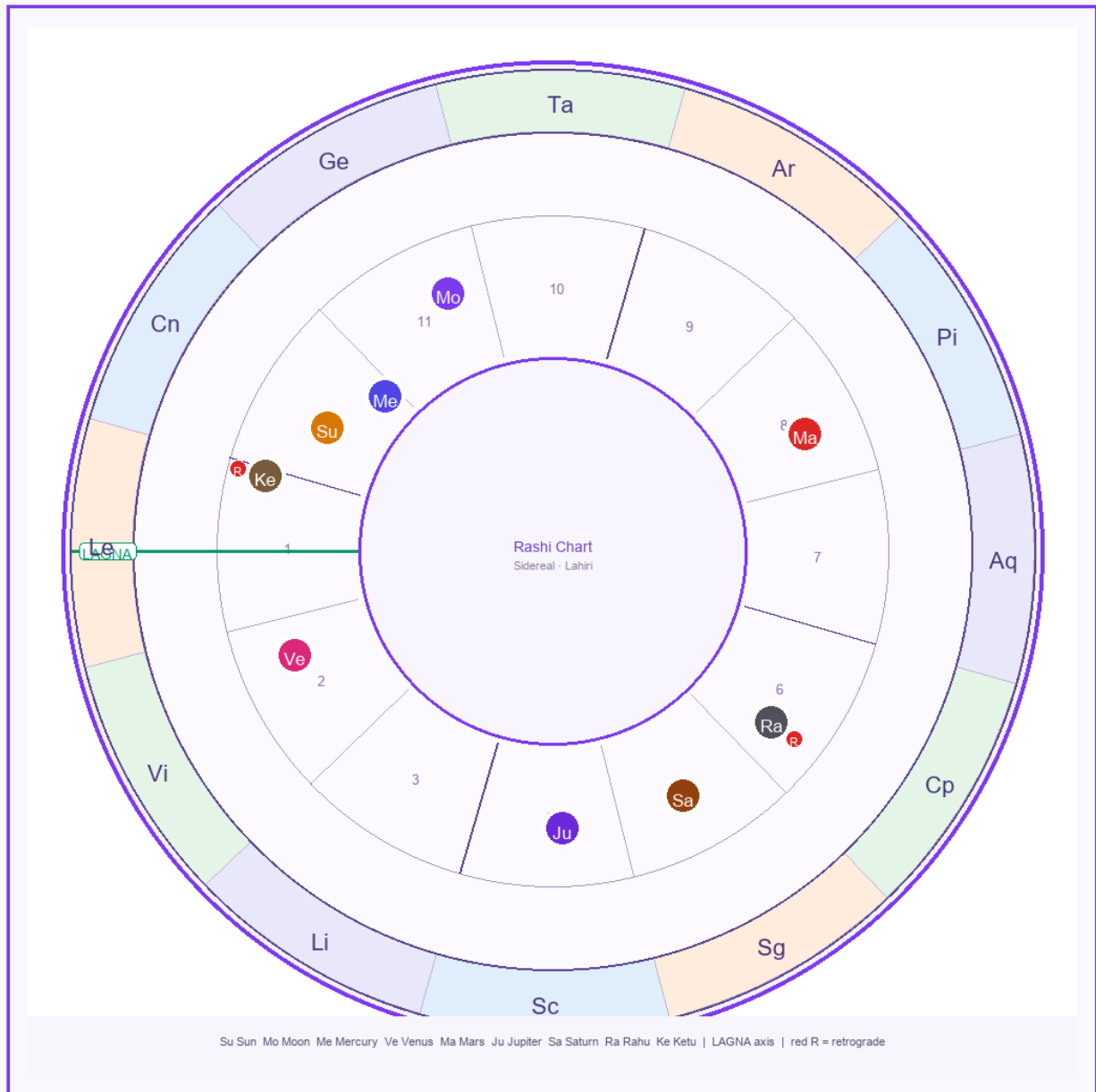
